The Human Rights for Syrians Initiative (HRSI) provides a hub of centralized, credible, and accessible information and resources to Syrian refugees in the U.S. and to those planning to come to the U.S. seeking asylum. HRSI provides legal representation in asylum cases and a reliable referral system for legal representation in immediate and long-term social and emergency services.
